

## QANTAS 787 Dreamliner

Qantas has revealed its next generation Premium Economy seat which will debut on the airline's fleet of Boeing 787-9 Dreamliners from October 2017 on the Melbourne to Los Angeles service. The Dreamliner will also be flying the non-stop Perth to London service from March 2018.

## QANTAS Digital Boarding Passes AU-NZ services



Qantas mobile check-in and digital boarding passes for passengers travelling between Australia and New Zealand is now available for direct flights across the Tasman. The check-in is available through the web and mobile on [www.qantas.com](http://www.qantas.com) and will be extended to the Qantas app in June 2017—all with the digital boarding pass on your mobile device. The service will be progressively rolled-out to other international destinations on the Qantas network by early 2018.

## AMERICAN AIRLINES 787-9 Dreamliner to Sydney



From 8 November 2017, American Airlines Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner will commence services between Sydney & Los Angeles replacing the Boeing 777-300ER. This new aircraft will offer travellers Economy, Main Cabin Extra, Premium Economy and Business classes.

## DELTA AIR LINES Los Angeles Terminal Relocation



Delta Air Lines has now relocated from Terminals 5 & 6 to Terminals 2 & 3 at Los Angeles International Airport. Airside bus connections to flights operated by Delta's SkyTeam partners in Terminals 2 & 3 and Tom Bradley International Terminal will be available eliminating the need for travellers to leave and re-enter the secure area.

## VIRGIN AUSTRALIA Los Angeles Terminal Change & Lounge



As part of the Los Angeles International Airport operations and terminal changes, the Virgin Australia check-in will relocate from Terminal 3 to counters 82-91 at Terminal 2, effective now. Transfer buses will operate from Terminals 2 & 3 for travellers connecting on a Virgin Australia flight departing from Tom Bradley International Terminal. Virgin Australia travellers with connecting flights who require a bus transfer can present their boarding pass at the Bus Gates located near Gate 35 (T3) and Gate 22 (T2) to utilise this service. **Virgin Australia Lounge** access remains at Tom Bradley International Terminal where eligible guests can access the Etihad First and Business Class Lounges.

## VIRGIN AUSTRALIA Regional Queensland Operations



Effective 17 July 2017, Virgin Australia will no longer operate selected regional services, however Alliance Airlines will commence operations on these routes with Virgin Australia to codeshare on these services:

- Brisbane—Bundaberg
- Brisbane—Moranbah
- Brisbane—Gladstone
- Brisbane—Port Macquarie



Flights on these routes will continue to earn Velocity Points and Status Credits for Velocity Frequent Flyer members. Travellers who have existing bookings on these routes from 17 July 2017 onwards will be reaccommodated on the Alliance Airlines services.

## JAPAN AIRLINES New Melbourne—Tokyo Service

Japan Airlines will launch new non stop services between Melbourne and Tokyo (Narita) commencing 02 September 2017. The service will depart Melbourne at 12.05am and arrive into Narita at 9.05am whilst the return flight will depart Narita at 10.30am, arriving in Melbourne at 9.55pm. Economy, Premium Economy and Business Classes will be offered on this service operating on a Boeing 787-8 aircraft.
